We specialize in providing comprehensive scholarship services, which includes financial evaluation of each family and a proposed tuition assistance amount. Our goal is to financially assist families that choose to educate their children in private schools that has Christ as the central theme and focus in their curriculum and services.

Available scholarship funds are derived solely from donor directed contributions designated to ASFVA. We can accommodate Virginia EISTC donations.

Distribution of funds are needs-based according to family size, income (not more than 300% of the current poverty guidelines, with adjustments for eligible students with a disability), and total tuition.

Scholarships are available for any qualifying student (VA resident attending a VA school).
